**2017 Stationery Levy and Booklist Information**

It is that time of year again where we are making important plans for next year. Like this year, students from Kindergarten to Year 2 will again have a Stationery Levy.

Having the levy makes it far simpler for you as the parent to organise items and it will be easier for teachers to distribute stationery. Items are also cheaper when purchased in bulk.

The Stationery Levy charge for 2017 will be \$125.

In addition to the Levy, students in Kindergarten to Year 2 require the following items to be brought to school on the first day. Petty cash covers the cost of items such as Mother's Day and Father's Day gifts and cooking ingredients.

### 2017 Levy and Booklist Information

It is that time of year again where we are making important plans for next year. Like this year, students from Kindergarten to Year 6 will continue to have a Stationery Levy rather than a booklist.

Having a levy makes it simpler for you as the parent to organise items and it is easier for teachers to distribute stationery. Items are cheaper when purchased in bulk.

The Stationery Levy charges for 2017 for Years 3 – 6 will be \$125, the same as this year. The Levy will be used to purchase books, pencils, files and any textbooks requested by the teacher.

In addition to the Levy, students in Years 3 - 6 require the following items to be brought to school on the first day. These items are not consumables and can be carried over from the previous year (should your child still have them):

- ✓ Pencil case
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Ruler
- ✓ Small simple calculator
- ✓ Sharpener
- ✓ Clipboard (which opens out)
- ✓ Headphones
- ✓ Recorder (Year 4 only)
- ✓ A3 Handy Pouch – we call this the 'Communication Folder.' New students – we will arrange this purchase on your behalf.
- ✓ Sunscreen
- ✓ Hand sanitizer 375mL.
- ✓ 2 X Boxes of Tissues.

Please ensure all items are LABELLED and brought to school on the first day. It is helpful to us if you place the scissors, calculator, ruler and sharpener in the pencil case.

Items such as scrap books, writing books, pens and pencils will be given out to students by teachers.
