2022 Stationery Levy and Booklist Information

It is that time of year again where we are making important plans for next year. Like this year, students from Kindergarten to Year 6 will continue to have a Stationery Levy rather than a booklist. Having a levy makes it simpler for you as the parent to organise items and it is easier for teachers to distribute stationery. Items are also cheaper when purchased in bulk.

The Stationery Levy charge is \$125 per student and will be on your 2022 annual statement. The Levy will be used to purchase writing books, pencils, files and any textbooks required for the year. These materials will be distributed by teachers during the first week of Term 1.

In addition to the Levy, Year 3 students require the following items. Most of these items are not consumables and can be carried over from the previous year (should your child still have them):
