

UNIFORM RULES

Students and parents of St James' Anglican School must understand the spirit, intention and values base that determine in which the School uniform rules. The decision of the Principal is final with respect to what is acceptable.

General Principles

- The correct uniform is to be worn at all times.
- All school uniform and personal property, including shoes, must be clearly marked.
- All uniform is to be kept clean, well pressed and in good condition.
- Shorts and trousers should fit and be worn correctly. Over-size shorts are not acceptable. Shorts must be a minimum of mid-thigh length.
- Skirts/dresses must touch at least the top part of the knee when standing upright.
- No visible undergarments.
- Students must be clean shaven. Students will be asked to shave at school or go home.
- Black lace-up dress shoes to be well polished.
- The broad-brimmed hat is **COMPULSORY** from Kindergarten to Year 12 in Term 1 and Term 4. Students are encouraged to wear their hat in Term 2 and Term 3.
- Tracksuit tops are not to be worn with formal uniform.
- Blazers are to be worn with formal uniform to and from school.
- A St James' school bag must be used for books and equipment.

Jewellery

- Jewellery (necklaces, bracelets, rings, anklets etc) cannot be worn apart from a watch, earrings, medical alert bracelet.
- Students are permitted to wear a plain gold or silver thin chain with a cross or symbol of the faith they practice.
- Students with pierced ears may wear one pair of small plain gold or silver studs or sleepers. The sleepers and studs must be no greater than 3-5mm in diameter.
- Students are permitted to wear one earring instead of one in each ear if they prefer.
- No other body piercings are permitted.
- Students wearing jewellery outside these rules will have the item confiscated and returned at the end of the term.
- A single set of additional clear plastic studs may be worn by students in Year 10 Year 12 to keep
 additional ear piercings open or in piercings that are not fully healed. They are not allowed to wear
 spacing studs that create an enlarged hole in the ear lobe or elsewhere. No tape or band aids are to be
 worn to cover additional piercings.
 - ✓ Students in Years 10s Year 12 who wish to have additional ear piercings, other than the allowed single set, will need to abide by the following rules.
- Additional piercings in the ear must occur in December immediately after Awards Evening. Students must allow sufficient time for new holes to heal and a clear plastic stud replacement to be inserted <u>before</u> the return to school. <u>At the commencement of the new school year there will be only one set of plain studs/sleepers permitted with any additional holes filled with the clear platic studs.</u>
- Therefore during term time there are ony one set of earrings permitted in the lower lobe.

Sport Shoe

- Students will be permitted to wear a sports shoe that meets the following criteria:
 - (The colour on the bulk of the shoe **must not** be entirely fluorescent)
 - ✓ Fluoro highlights only are allowed. The spirit of this rule is that most sports shoes will be permitted provided the majority of the shoe is NOT FLUORESCENT.
 - ✓ Black, white, grey, pale colour sports shoes are acceptable (not Vans, Converse or fashion shoes).
 - ✓ The shoelaces must match the colour of the shoe, no multi colours or bright contrasting colours.
 - ✓ Before purchasing, please check with the PE staff if you are unsure.

^{**} Sports caps will be available for PE lessons/carnivals only on a trial basis.**



Hair

- Hair must be natural colour.
- Hair can touch the collar but must not go past it.
- Hair must be tied up/tied at the nape of the neck and not hanging in the eyes.
- Scrunchies must be orange, blue or white. Hair ties are to be the same or similar colour to the students natural hair colour.
- No topknots, dreadlocks or extreme undercuts.
- A number two is the minimum hair length for shaved hair.
- No lines and/or patterns are to be shaved in the hair.
- No hair extensions.

Eyebrows

• No Eyebrow lines/slits

Makeup and Tattoos

- No makeup.
- No fake eyelashes.
- Tattoos are discouraged.
- Any student that has a tattoo must have it covered at all times including at swimming carnivals.

Nails

- Nail polish not permitted.
- Acrylic nails are permitted. MUST be clear, and not go beyond the tip of the finger. NOT shaped to a point or curved.
